It's up to you to decide how your bequest will be used, however a general gift allows us to direct the monies received to the areas of greatest need.

Clause for your Will:

To set up a legacy gift, which will benefit the animals, simply ask your lawyer to add the following statement to your will:

"I give to the London Humane Society, 624 Clarke Road, London Ontario, N5V 3K5, charitable registration number 119023869RR0001, the sum of \$ _____, or _____% of the residue of my estate or my property at _____ in the City of _____ . The disposition of my bequest is to be used by the London Humane Society at its discretion."

If you already have a Will:

You need not re-write the entire document to include a bequest to London Humane Society. Instead, a simple clause known as a codicil can be used to amend your Will. Below, you'll find examples of codicil language that you may wish to make use of. Of course, we strongly recommend that you consult with your lawyer or estate planner when considering making a bequest.

Percentage of Estate Gift

"I give to London Humane Society _____ per cent of the value of my estate to be used for its general purposes."

Residual Gift

"I give to London Humane Society one hundred per cent (100%) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate for its general purposes."

Fixed Amount Gift

"I give to London Humane Society the sum of \$ _____ to be used for its general purposes."
